





4 Days - 3 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

Day 1 - An early departure from your hometown has you traveling to **Clarksville, TN** ... once the second largest producer of dark-fired tobacco and home of the largest tobacco warehouse in the world. Learn about the history of this million-dollar industry and how Type 22 tobacco solidified Clarksville's standing in the Global Market as you **visit a local tobacco farm**. After your visit, check into your hotel and freshen up before this evening's activities. A delicious **BBQ dinner with authentic Bluegrass Music** has been arranged for you at the **Old Glory Distillery**.

Day 2 - Following breakfast at your hotel, depart for a **tour of Historic Collingsville**, which is nestled on 40 rolling acres. The tour will take you back in time to the mid-1800s and teach you about life for the settlers during this period. With 16 log buildings filled with authentic furnishings, you will be transported back to days gone by. During your visit, you will view special demonstrations, including churning, weaving, and spinning as you learn about life in Tennessee in the 1800s. After the tour, you will visit **Sweet Charlotte**, a fun shop that sells old fashioned candy, malted milk shakes, flavored popcorn and the largest variety of sodas in the state. Enjoy lunch on your own and participate in the **Soda Showdown**, a blind taste test of several fun sodas. This afternoon you will arrive in Bon Aqua, TN to visit the **Storyteller Farm**, which was owned by Johnny Cash for 30 years as he called it the "center of the universe." Enjoy a **tour of the house** and visit to the **American Garage** which features a chock full of interesting memorabilia, including Minnie Pearl's Cadillac. You will also be **entertained by Mark Alan Cash**, Johnny's nephew, hear stories about growing up with Uncle Johnny. After your visit, return to your hotel to relax and freshen up before dinner. This evening you will arrive at the **Great Biscuit Bakeoff** where your group will divide into teams for a **biscuit competition**, followed by a delicious **dinner at Tanglewood**, which features a pasta bar and chicken. Your day will end with a performance by the **Passenger Creek Bluegrass Band**.

Day 3 - Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then depart with your guide for a visit to **Fort Defiance** overlooking the Cumberland River, the only Civil War site in Clarksville. Learn about Clarksville's Civil War story with interactive displays and re-enactors. From the fort, you can enjoy the beautiful views of downtown Clarksville. Afterwards, continue to the **Customs House Museum & Cultural Center**, the second largest general interest museum in Tennessee. The Museum features a huge variety of exhibits, including a massive model train exhibit, a unique variety of art, and a large collection of Boehm Porcelain. Continue to **Downtown Clarksville** to enjoy lunch on your own at one of the restaurants. This afternoon you will visit the **Trazo Meadery for a tasting** of their locally-made mead which is wine made from honey. Learn about the process and meet the makers. Later, continue to the **Beachaven Winery for a tour and tasting** which includes a **souvenir glass**. Beachaven is one of the largest wineries in Tennessee and the only one that produces French-method Champagne. After your visit, return to your hotel to relax and freshen up before dinner. This evening's dinner will be at **Ruby Cora**, followed by the delightful sounds of "**Music Through the Years**" ... featuring memorable songs from the Andrew Sisters to Elvis, WWII Era to Rock & Roll, and Country Music to Patriotic salutes.

Day 4 – After breakfast, check-out and depart for home with lasting memories of your trip to **Clarksville, TN**.
